As I think about the future, I feel hopeful and excited. By bridging the generational divide and having meaningful dialogues, we can combine the wisdom of experience with the dynamism of youth. Together, we can build on the lessons of the past while embracing the promise of the years to come for the benefits of our students

Nancy's interview has shown me that the old and new don't have to be opposites, but rather complementary forces. When harnessed well, they can propel us towards a brighter tomorrow. It's my hope that we can all open our minds and hearts to the transformative potential in the space between the generations and guide our students to a better future.
