Dear Colleagues and Friends

Dhabi University has approved the renaming of the Smart Learning Center to the Center for Faculty Development and Learning Innovation, with the aim of enhancing teaching and learning competencies at Abu Dhabi University and our sister college, Liwa College.

This change reflects our commitment to advancing faculty development and enhancing teaching and learning across disciplines. The Center will continue to support our efforts with an expanded focus on innovation in pedagogy, professional growth, and resources tailored to teaching needs.

During the academic year 2023-2024, a total of 18 interactive workshops were held, encompassing various categories in teaching and learning, conducted face-to-face, online, or in hybrid formats. Faculty and staff from both ADU and LC participated, with 556 attending at least one of our sessions throughout the current academic year. Additionally, 122 faculty members attended more than six sessions.

Examples of topics covered include: the art and science of leadership, utilizing the digitalization system in ADU, using AI to create content and provide feedback, creating an inviting classroom environment, an introduction to Scite, NodeBook & ChatGPT workshops, applying reflective and metacognitive strategies in STEM education, AhaSlides: product updates workshop, assessment and grade distribution, grade inflation: causes, consequences, and solutions in higher education, constructive alignment (CA) and closing the loop, and assessments, and ChatGPT: challenges and opportunities.

the Fall Faculty Professional Development Day focused on "Faculty-Student Mentoring: Effective Mentoring Can Be Learned, Not Taught," and the Spring Faculty Professional Development Day centered on "Pedagogical Approaches and Assessment Practices."
