ADU and the Authority of Social Contribution - Ma'an Launch Pioneering Funding Initiative to Drive Long-Term Social Impact Across the UAE

UAE, Abu Dhabi, 13 March 2025: In line with the UAE's 'Year of Community' initiative to create inclusive spaces for collaboration and belonging, <u>Abu Dhabi University (ADU)</u> has concluded the first phase of the community-funded building in the Al Mafraq area in partnership with <u>the Authority of Social Contribution – Ma'an</u>. Covering an area of 4,300 m², this initiative will empower and support deserving and outstanding students throughout their academic journey.

At 30 percent completion, the milestone was attended by Professor Ghassan Aouad, Chancellor of ADU, H.E. Abdullah Al Ameri, Director General of the Authority of Social Contribution - Ma'an, and H.E. Faisal Al Hmoudi, Executive Director of the Social Investment Fund at the Authority of Social Contribution - Ma'an, with the presence of prominent representatives from both entities.

Through this initiative, the building will feature six shops, 16 offices, four warehouses and a marketplace. ADU will lease the building to community members, supporting local business growth. Furthermore, a proportion of rental revenue will be dedicated to support student financing through scholarships

Professor Ghassan Aouad, Chancellor of Abu Dhabi University (ADU), said: "This project represents a significant milestone in ADU's commitment to fostering a culture of giving and creating a lasting positive impact in the UAE and beyond. Through collaborating with the Authority of Social Contribution - Ma'an, we are investing in future leaders, expanding educational accessibility and advancing the nation's knowledge-based economy. This initiative aligns with the UAE's Year of Community, showcasing higher education's pivotal role in driving social inclusion and economic improvement, further cementing ADU's position as a leading hub for academic excellence and talent development in the country."



This building is part of the Authority's recently launched 'From The Community To The Community' initiative, in which a label is placed on key community-driven projects across the city to foster a culture of giving in Abu Dhabi and acts as a physical tribute to the collective community efforts, demonstrating the power of unity.
