ADU Concludes the 'International Conference on Advancing Sustainable Futures 2023'

In line with its commitment to exchange knowledge and expertise with leaders in the academic field, Abu Dhabi University (ADU) concluded the 'International Conference on Advancing Sustainable Futures 2023.'
