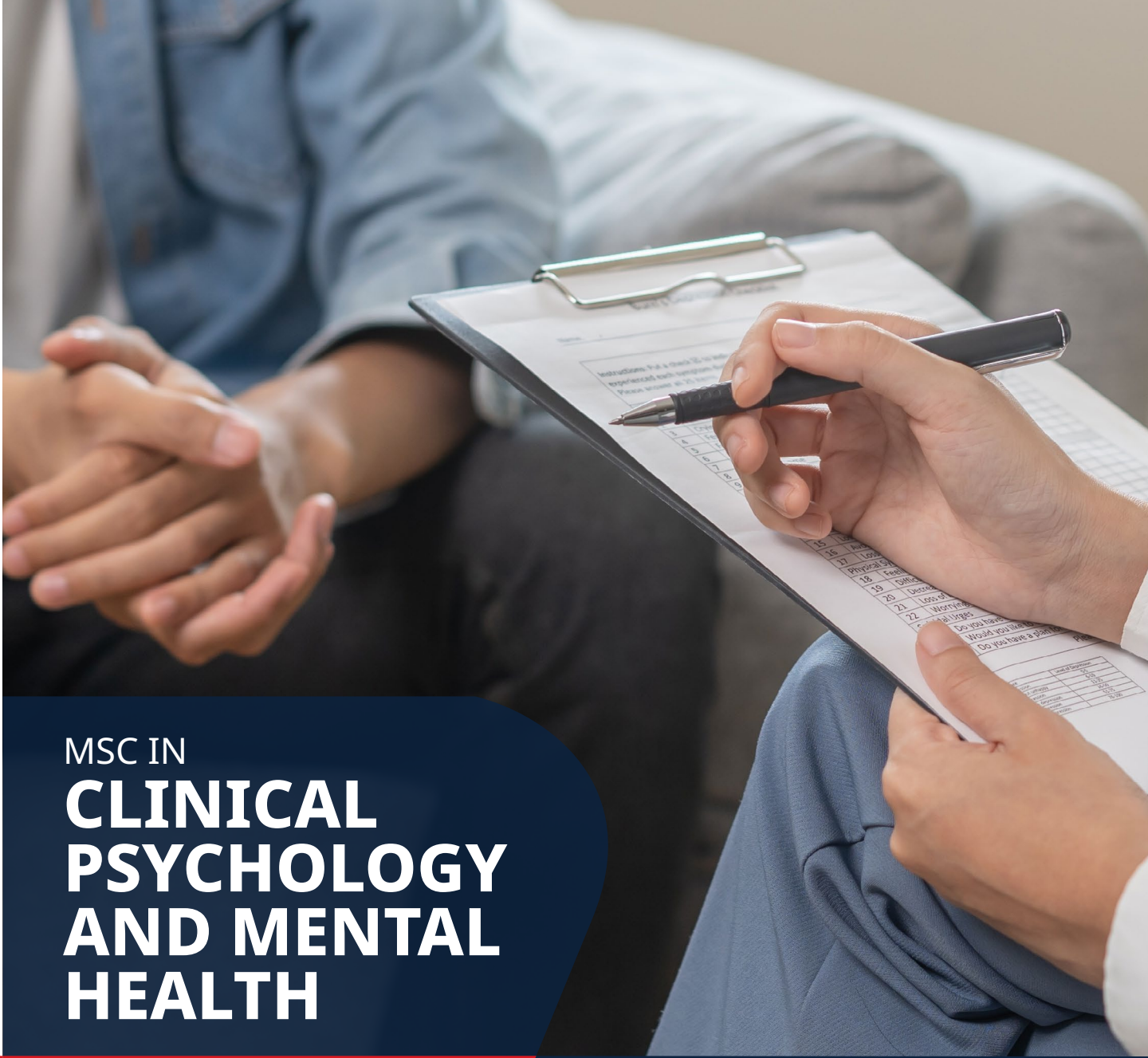

MSC IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY AND MENTAL HEALTH

Program Overview

The Master of Science (MSc) in Clinical Psychology and Mental Health at Abu Dhabi University prepares future mental health professionals with advanced clinical competencies, research capabilities, and ethical grounding. The program equips students with in-depth knowledge of psychological theory, diagnostics, and evidence-based therapeutic interventions while addressing contemporary mental health challenges at the individual and community levels.

This program, delivered through academic coursework, supervised clinical internships, and an original thesis project, provides students with hands-on experience essential for professional licensure and leadership roles in mental health services across the UAE and beyond.



Graduates will gain the following knowledge and skills:

- Advanced understanding of psychopathology, psychological theories, and treatment modalities
- Proficiency in clinical assessment, diagnosis, and therapeutic intervention planning
- Competence in delivering individual and group psychotherapy using evidence-based techniques
- Skills in conducting and applying research in clinical psychology through a graduate thesis
- Professional communication, supervision, and collaboration in interdisciplinary mental health teams

This master's program significantly enhances knowledge and clinical competencies, providing graduates with specialized psychological assessment, diagnosis, and intervention expertise. It delivers rigorous training in advanced therapeutic techniques and clinical supervision, preparing students for high-impact roles within healthcare systems and mental health services.
