F in the course and one semester suspension

The following students will receive a grade of “F” in the course and a one-semester suspension due to sufficient evidence of cheating sheet and possession of a mobile phone during an examination. Although some students denied the allegations, the AIC found them responsible for the violation. The AI Committee determined that the students were given an opportunity to cooperate with the investigation and demonstrate that they did not possess unauthorized materials; however, they declined to do so. Consequently, based on the available evidence, the AIC concluded that the allegations were substantiated.

F in the course				
The student will receive a grade of “F” in the course as the only sanction. The AIC determined that there was a degree of negligence on the part of the faculty member in allowing the student to re-enter the examination room and continue the exam after leaving. The Committee noted that instructors should be advised that students who leave an examination should not be permitted to return and resume the assessment. The AIC also found the student responsible for the violation, as the student failed to cooperate with the investigation and did not provide sufficient evidence to demonstrate that they were not in possession of an unauthorized or hidden device.

Warning and make-up exam

In the case of [REDACTED], the student demonstrated cooperation throughout the investigation. While certain circumstances raised suspicions, the AIC determined that the concerns were based primarily on doubt and were not supported by clear or sufficient evidence to substantiate a violation.

In the case of [REDACTED], the AIC determined that the incident resulted from an honest mistake. Therefore, the student should be permitted to take a make-up examination.
